

Priyasakhi Mahila Sangh made a significant move by opening its first Self Help Group (SHG) stall at Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar Airport in Indore on April 8, 2022. This initiative was in line with the Ministry of Civil Aviation (Government of India) and the Airport Authority of India's (AAI) new policy to support skilled artisans and provide them with a platform to showcase and sell their handmade products. The AAI introduced the 'AVSAR' scheme, allowing SHGs to exhibit and sell their self-made products at Indore Airport on a rotational basis, presenting a substantial opportunity for small communities.

The inauguration ceremony, held in the Departure Arena of Indore Airport, featured the presence of dignitaries like Mr. Abhay Rajangoankar (Commissioner, National Urban Livelihood Mission) and Mr. Ramesh Kumar (Director, Indore Airport). Ms. V. Nageshwari (AGM, Indore Airport), Ms. Arti Kushwah (CEO, Priyasakhi Mahila Sangh), and several other individuals associated with the initiative were also present.

The SHG stall displayed a diverse range of products, with prices ranging from Rs 50 to Rs 2000. The offerings included wall hangings, artificial flower pots, dolls and puppets, candles, festival essentials, masks, and handbags, all available in various colors and designs.

Customers praised the initiative for providing a platform for women from rural and slum areas to showcase and sell their products in a prime location like the airport. The women from the SHGs received positive feedback and encouragement for their professional management of the stall.
