<u>The Financial Literacy & Women Empowerment (FLWE)</u> <u>Program</u>

During the reporting period of June 2018, the Financial Literacy & Women Empowerment (FLWE) program conducted by Priyasakhi Mahila Sangh in Indore achieved significant milestones. The Master Trainers (MTs) successfully imparted training on the 2nd module, reaching a total of 5760 clients, which included the backlog of 1093 clients from May 2018. The training sessions covered a wide range of topics, including health, nutrition, financial inclusion, and investment strategies, ensuring holistic empowerment of the participants.

In terms of financial inclusion, 93 clients voluntarily opted for life insurance coverage, with a total sum assured amounting to Rupees 22,35,000. Furthermore, 250 clients opened saving bank accounts with ATM debit card facilities, enhancing their financial access. The program also succeeded in credit linking 25 Self-Help Groups (SHGs) with banks, securing a total credit amount of Rupees 1,07,30,000.

The initiative also facilitated the registration of 570 members for PAN cards, enabling them to access various financial services. Additionally, the FLWE program played a pivotal role in providing livelihood platforms, with 38 women beneficiaries registering for job work and employment opportunities through Rozgar Melas.

Despite challenges such as the summer vacation leading to clients' absence, the program achieved its targets and maintained a collaborative approach to address client issues. It showcased the potential of comprehensive FLWE programs in empowering women and fostering financial inclusion and sustainable livelihoods.

The program played a vital role in credit linking 25 Self-Help Groups (SHGs) with banks, securing a total credit amount of INR 1,07,30,000.

The initiative also facilitated the registration of 570 members for PAN cards, enabling them to access various financial services. Moreover, 38 women beneficiaries registered for job work and employment opportunities through Rozgar Melas, providing them with livelihood platforms.

Although the program faced challenges such as clients' absence due to summer vacations and issues related to connectivity and health, it successfully met its targets. The FLWE program showcased the potential for holistic empowerment, combining education, financial inclusion, and employment opportunities, thereby contributing to women's empowerment in the region.
